

<b>EAST BAY</b>	<b>Alameda County/Contra Costa County</b>
<b>BUS</b>	
<b>AC Transit (Local Service and Transbay)</b> <a href="http://www2.actransit.org/main.wu">http://www2.actransit.org/main.wu</a>	Operates 78 local lines within the East Bay and 27 Transbay lines to San Francisco and the Peninsula. AC Transit has an extensive network of Transbay bus lines connecting the East Bay to San Francisco and the Peninsula. Serving the 80, 580, and 880 freeway corridors of western Alameda and Contra Costa Counties, AC Transit offers 25 lines to the Transbay Terminal at First & Mission in downtown San Francisco from neighborhoods and Park & Ride lots between Richmond and Fremont. Transbay service is also available to Foster City, San Mateo and Stanford University across the San Mateo and Dumbarton bridges.
<b>County Connection</b> <a href="http://www.cccta.org/">http://www.cccta.org/</a>	Provides transit service within central Contra Costa County with connections to Pleasanton and Antioch. The County Connection serves Clayton, Concord, Danville, Lafayette, Martinez, Moraga, Orinda, Pleasant Hill, San Ramon, Walnut Creek, and unincorporated areas of central county.
<b>Dumbarton Express</b> <a href="http://www2.actransit.org/maps/#">http://www2.actransit.org/maps/#</a>	Provides weekday transbay bus service from Union City, Fremont, and Newark, across the Dumbarton bridge, to East Palo Alto, Menlo Park, downtown Palo Alto, Palo Alto Caltrain Station and Stanford Industrial Park. A consortium of AC Transit, BART, SamTrans, Union City Transit and Valley Transportation Authority provide the DB Express Service.
<b>Golden Gate Transit</b> <a href="http://www.goldengate.org">http://www.goldengate.org</a>	Provides daily bus service within Marin, Sonoma, San Francisco and Contra Costa counties. Golden Gate Ferry provides daily ferry service between Larkspur or Sausalito (Marin County) and San Francisco.
<b>Santa Clara VTA</b> <a href="http://www.vta.org">http://www.vta.org</a>	Provides service throughout Santa Clara County and partners with other systems for bus and rail service between Santa Clara County and the counties of Alameda, Santa Cruz, San Mateo and San Francisco.
<b>Tri Delta Transit</b> <a href="http://www.trideltatransit.com">http://www.trideltatransit.com</a>	Provides over 2,500,000 trips each year to a population of nearly 230,000 residents in the 225 square miles of Eastern Contra Costa County.
<b>Union City Transit</b> <a href="http://www.ci.union-city.ca.us/transit.html">http://www.ci.union-city.ca.us/transit.html</a>	Operates a bus system which coordinates with BART trains, AC Transit, and the Dumbarton Express to areas outside of the City.
<b>WestCAT</b> <a href="http://www.westcat.org">http://www.westcat.org</a>	Operates 11 local fixed routes, 4 express routes to the El Cerrito del Norte BART station, curb-to-curb Dial-A-Ride service, ADA Paratransit service, special transportation outside the WestCAT service area for seniors and persons with disabilities traveling into the Richmond and San Pablo areas, regional service to Martinez and Contra Costa College, and express transbay service from Hercules to the San Francisco Transbay Terminal.
<b>WHEELS</b> <a href="http://www.wheelsbus.com">http://www.wheelsbus.com</a>	Operates sixteen local routes serving Dublin, Pleasanton and Livermore. Express connections between Livermore and Dublin/Pleasanton BART are available. Express Bus service to Silicon Valley and between Walnut Creek and the Tri-Valley area is also available during commute hours.
<b>TRAIN</b>	
<b>ACE</b> <a href="http://www.acerail.com/">http://www.acerail.com/</a>	Operates eight commuter trains each weekday in the Altamont corridor: four a.m. westbound trains in the mornings, and four p.m. eastbound trains in the afternoon and evenings. ACE travels between Stockton and San Jose, with additional stops in Lathrop/Manteca, Tracy, Vasco, Livermore, Pleasanton, Fremont, Great America, and Santa Clara (currently suspended station, effective August 1, 2005). ACE in conjunction with WHEELS provides free shuttle bus service (Wheels Route #54) between the ACE Pleasanton Station and the Dublin BART station and return, and service to Stoneridge Mall via Wheels route #53.
<b>Capitol Corridor InterCity Rail</b> <a href="http://www.capitolcorridor.org">http://www.capitolcorridor.org</a>	Serves 16 stations along its 170-mile route, and offers frequent service between Sacramento, the San Francisco Bay Area and Silicon Valley/San Jose. Connections to BART are available at the Oakland Coliseum and Richmond Intermodal Stations.

The Ferry runs Monday through Friday only, expect for major holidays.
