<b>American Canyon Transit (ACT)</b> <a href="http://www.nctpa.net/routes/index.cfm?rt=10&amp;Submit=Go">http://www.nctpa.net/routes/index.cfm?rt=10&amp;Submit=Go</a>	Service begins and ends at the Safeway at State Highway 29 and American Canyon Road. Service begins at 7:30 am and ends at 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday. No service is provided on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays.
<b>Benicia Breeze</b> <a href="http://www.ci.benicia.ca.us/transit">http://www.ci.benicia.ca.us/transit</a>	Provides local bus service within the City of Benicia and a regional express service between Pleasant Hill BART Station, Martinez Amtrak Station and Vallejo Ferry Terminal via Benicia. Connections are available to The County Connection, WHEELS, Fairfield/Suisun Transit System, Vallejo Transit, Baylink Express, Baylink Ferry, BART, Amtrak California, Amtrak, Capitol Corridor, Tri Delta Transit, WestCAT and VINE. Benicia Breeze Paratransit provides demand responsive ADA paratransit service with ¾ of a mile of Benicia Breeze routes.

<b>Fairfield and Suisun Transit (FAST)</b> <a href="http://www.fasttransit.org">http://www.fasttransit.org</a>	Provides local transit service in the Solano County cities of Fairfield (which consists of the Travis Airforce Base and the Cordelia Village Area) and Suisun. Fairfield-Suisun Transit also operates routes that connect Fairfield to the outlying cities of Vacaville, Davis, Sacramento and Pleasant Hill.
<b>Golden Gate Transit</b> <a href="http://www.goldengate.org">http://www.goldengate.org</a>	Provides daily bus service within Marin, Sonoma, San Francisco and Contra Costa counties. Golden Gate Ferry provides daily ferry service between Larkspur or Sausalito (Marin County) and San Francisco.

<b>Santa Rosa CityBus</b> <a href="http://www.srcity.org/tp">http://www.srcity.org/tp</a>	Operates seventeen regular routes, primarily within the City of Santa Rosa, to a population of approximately 160,869. Hours of operation are 6:00 a.m. to 8:25 p.m. Monday through Friday; 6:00 a.m. to 8:15 p.m. on Saturday; and 10:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. on Sunday.

Connections to VINE at St. Helena City Hall (northbound side) and Main at Pope Streets (southbound side) in downtown St. Helena, and to Lake Transit at St. Helena Hospital.

Most routes begin and end at the Ulatis Cultural Center and operate approximately 11 hours a day Monday through Friday, starting between 6:30am and 7:00am. Saturday service operates for approximately 8 hours starting at 8:30am. There is no Sunday service.
