<b>Golden Gate Transit</b> <a href="http://www.goldengate.org">http://www.goldengate.org</a>	Provides daily bus service within Marin, Sonoma, San Francisco and Contra Costa counties. Golden Gate Ferry provides daily ferry service between Larkspur or Sausalito (Marin County) and San Francisco.
<b>Muni (SF)</b> <a href="http://www.sfmta.com">http://www.sfmta.com</a>	Provides transit service within the city and county of San Francisco 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Muni service is provided by the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA). The SFMTA manages transportation in San Francisco, California.

The transit district also offers Redi-Wheels paratransit service for persons with disabilities who are unable to ride SamTrans.

<b>Capitol Corridor InterCity Rail</b> <a href="http://www.capitolcorridor.org">http://www.capitolcorridor.org</a>	Serves 16 stations along its 170-mile route, and offers frequent service between Sacramento, the San Francisco Bay Area and Silicon Valley/San Jose. Connections to BART are available at the Oakland Coliseum and Richmond Intermodal Stations. Discounted rates are available for frequent travelers, and free transfers are available for many local transit systems.
